I came up with some ideas about how I can use Flash in my classroom after viewing the [Literacy Center](#) link. I think I could use Flash to create activities for my students to learn their vocabulary words. Most of my students can't read yet and this use of Flash can give them an engaging activity in which they can learn the words and their meanings. I would use voice to pronounce the vocabulary word when the student scrolls over it. Then when the user clicks on the vocabulary word I would use Flash to read the definition of the word.

For our Collaboration Project we plan to use Flash to create our banner. We plan to use some eye catching movements. We also plan to use the scroll over technique to give the explanation of each of the posted resources to make it easier for users to decide what they are interested in.
